



Y City Camp - MUST KNOW FOR SUMMER 2021

Hey Y City Camp families! David and his team of fantastic counsellors are so excited to have your children here this summer. We are going to have an amazing time together, with tons of outdoor activities, water games, sports, crafts, singing, dancing and laughing with new friends.

Here are a few things you need to know before your child comes for his or her first day of camp:

Please send with campers every day

All items sent to camp must be clearly labeled with the camper's name.

- Hat
- Camp T-shirt (2 will be provided per camper on the first day of camp)
- Refillable water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Bathing suit
- Towel
- Waterproof shoes for outdoor activities (no flips flops please - campers will be running around in them)
- Waterproof bag for wet clothes
- Snacks - nut-free
- Lunch - nut-free
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- 3 masks in a labelled waterproof bag
- Full change of clothes (underwear, socks, t-shirt, shorts) in a waterproof bag with camper's name

Drop off, pick up and early departure / late arrival procedures

Only campers and staff are permitted to enter the Y's building. All adults picking up and dropping off campers will wait outside the building at designated locations - see our site map for details.

Morning Drop Off - Good weather

Campers can be dropped off in the morning anytime between 8-9am, and in good weather, regular drop off will take place in Mackenzie King Park right across the street from the Y (*Station 3*). There will be check-in tables set up, and Y City Camp staff waiting to welcome campers. Families should line up 2 meters apart while waiting to check in campers. No camper can be dropped off without being checked in with a staff person.

Inclusion campers are always dropped off at the main door of the Y (*Station 1*).

Morning Drop Off - Bad weather

In case of bad weather, all drop off will take place in front of the Y (*Stations 1&2*). Staff will be at the stations to welcome the campers. Families should line up 2 meters apart while waiting to check in campers. No camper can be dropped off without being checked in with a staff member. **Inclusion campers are always dropped off at the main door of the Y (*Station 1*).**

Afternoon Pick Up - all weather

Campers can be picked up from camp between 3:30 and 4pm. Campers will be indoors, and staff members will be waiting outside the Y at *Stations 1 & 2*. Give your child's name to the staff, and the child will be brought out to meet you.

For campers who are signed up for after-camp care, please give your child's name at *Station 1*. After care closes at 5:30pm.

Arrival after 9am / departure before 3:30pm

If your child has an appointment and will arrive at camp after 9am, or must leave camp before 3:30pm, please send an email in advance to ycitycamp@ymywha.com. When you have arrived to pick up or drop off your child, please go to *Station 1*, and call **438-879-9621**. A staff member will come outside to meet you there. It could take time to retrieve your child from his or her activity, so please allow for extra time.

Covid related policies
