

Y City Camp Policies & Procedures

Please send with campers every day

****All items sent to camp must be clearly labeled with the camper's name****

- Refillable water bottle
- Bathing suit and towel
- Waterproof bag for wet clothes
- Snacks and lunch: nut-free
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- 3 masks in a labelled waterproof bag (now that we're in the **Green Zone**, masks are only for those families who want their child wearing masks)
- Full change of clothes (underwear, socks, t-shirt, pants) in a waterproof bag with camper's name
- Winter gear (warm jacket, hat, waterproof gloves, snow pants and neck warmer)

Drop Off & Pick Up Procedures

All campers must be formally checked in every morning, and formally checked out in the afternoon. Do not drop off or pick up your child without signing your camper in or out with a day camp staff member.

Morning Drop Off

Camp officially begins at 9am. Families should line up 2 meters apart while waiting to check in campers. No camper can be dropped off without being checked in with a staff person.

Afternoon Pick Up

Campers can be picked up from camp between 3:45pm and 4pm. Parents must show their ID to the day camp staff in the Grover Auditorium. No camper may leave the building without being signed out with the counsellor.

Arrival after 9am / Departure before 3:45pm

If your child will arrive at camp after 9am, or must leave camp before 3:45pm, please present yourself at the front desk and wait with your child / children until a day camp staff member arrives.

If you are to pick your child / children up early from camp, it could take time to retrieve your child from his or her activity, so please allow for extra time.

COVID Screening Procedures

Each and every morning, upon dropping off their children, parents must verbally confirm that no one in their family has Covid symptoms. If any camper or member of his or her family has Covid symptoms, the camper **must not be dropped off at camp**.

If a camper develops symptoms during the camp day, he or she will be put in an isolated room and the parents will be called immediately to retrieve him or her. All siblings of the camper will also be removed from their bunks, isolated and sent home.

Nut Policy

No nuts or nut products are permitted at Y City Day Camp, whether for lunch or snacks. This includes granola bars with nuts, Nutella, nut butters, etc. Children are permitted to bring food that “may contain traces of nuts”.

Children in our day camp are not allowed to share foods with each other.
